

Commitment to Education and Unitas Responsibilities Statement

I affirm that Unitas is a classical Christian cooperative designed to assist me in my home schooling endeavors. Unitas is not to be used as a Monday and Thursday dropoff service; whereas this is the only schooling my child receives. I understand that in order to get the most out of the chosen curriculum, it is in my child's best interest to complete the work assigned by the tutor, to the best of his/her ability. I also realize that I have the freedom to have my child complete the work in a way I feel is best for my child's academic needs. For example, some work may be completed orally rather than written.

I understand it is not Unitas' responsibility to verify that the work is completed. I answer first to the Lord, and second to my county in the state of Maryland regarding the completion of a thorough and regular curriculum for my child.

Additionally, if for any reason Unitas learns I am using the services provided in ways other than is intended, I agree that Unitas reserves the right to evaluate my continuing participation in the cooperative. Unitas will use quarterly test scores, along with parent and tutor feedback as a resource for this decision. I understand it is Unitas' desire to support my home schooling efforts, not replace them, and to help ensure classroom and academic success for my child(ren). Should there be any concern regarding my child(ren)'s progress, a meeting and/or test may be requested by the tutor, parent and Board member, as a team, to make sure my child is in the best educational environment for his/her needs.

Finally, Unitas is a cooperative. We all work together to make the workload as light as possible for each of us individually. I understand if I am not fulfilling my committee position or regularly attending parent meetings, then this may impact my return the following year.
